Sub: Regarding containment measures for the Lockdown in the State for containing the spread of COVID-19.

Sir/Madam,

This is in continuation of the order issued by Government of Nagaland, vide Order No. CSO/GAB-I/COM/GEN-1/2020, Dated, Kohima, the 24th March, 2020, detailing the various measures to be taken for enforcing Lockdown of the State for preventing and containing the spread of Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

1. You have to immediately form a Core Team headed, preferably, by the Additional Deputy Commissioner (Hq), to look into and take remedial measures to ensure that the supply of essential commodities and other basic necessities as well as the Supply Chains remain unhindered in any manner. For this, control room may also be set up which may be well publicised so that any person/supplier(s) facing any problem in this regard could contact for seeking assistance. Details of the formation of such teams and the control numbers may be immediately shared with the State Emergency Operation Centre (SEOC), Nagaland, the numbers of which are, 0370-2291120/2291122 Telefax: 0370-2291123, email: seoc.nsdma@gmail.com. It may be mentioned that for the entire State, the 24X 7 control room /office for all matters relating to the Lockdown will function from SEOC.
2. You may ensure that all types of construction works, including roads/houses/brick kilns, etc are immediately stopped. You are to ensure strict compliance of the same. Further, all types of manufacturing unit, except, those dealing with essential commodities shall remain closed.
3. You may take all measures to ensure that crowd don't build up at any of the shops dealing with Food/Groceries/Fruits/Vegetables/Fish & Meat, etc., which are being allowed to remain open during Lockdown. In this regard, work out a plan which may include having timings during which the shops in any particular area may be allowed to remain open as well as ensuring that people, to the extent possible, go to the nearest shops only for purchase and also that only one person in a family comes out to do shopping. You may also coordinate with the Urban Local Bodies and get marking done in front of the shops so that social distancing is maintained when people go there for shopping.
