**Sub :- Stricter implementation of guidelines on Containment Zone-reg.**

Sir,

It has been brought to the notice of the government that, non-essential movement of people is continuing into and from the Containment Zone to other districts in the State. This is in violation of Para 3 of this office order of even number dated 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2021 regarding declaration of Containment Zones for Dimapur and Kohima.

2. Therefore, the District Task Force on COVID-19 are requested to check and restrict non-essential movement of people as indicated above.

3. The movement of inter-state transit passengers may be allowed as per provisions of Revised Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for returnees and travellers entering Nagaland dated 29<sup>th</sup> April 2021.
