Sub :- Ramping up of testing for COVID-19 in the districts and preparation of review plans for arrangement of referral transport facilities-reg.

Sir,

A review of the total tests for COVID-19 conducted by the districts for the past few weeks has been made by the State Level War Room and it is noticed that, in many districts the average daily number of tests being conducted is very less. It is also noticed that in some districts, the overall tests conducted till now when compared to the districts' own population (Census 2011) is very low. The **Annexures I & II** enclosed showing the average daily number of tests conducted (over a period of the last 15 days) and the percentages of the tests conducted to the respective district population (Census 2011) may be seen.

2. All Deputy Commissioners and Chief Medical Officers and in particular the districts where testing is dismally low are requested to immediately ramp up the testing.
3. Further, all the District Task Forces are advised to look into the matter relating to arrangement of referral transport facilities and prepare Comprehensive Micro Plan for the District.
4. Action taken in this regard may be submitted to the State Level War Room for perusal.
